Finals

Performances for finals are ordered by prelim is as follows: 6 lowest prelim scores will be drawn for the first 6 performance spots, 6 highest prelim scores will be drawn for the last 6 final performance spots. The first performance is at 6:15 PM and the final performance is at 9:30 PM. Finals is followed by performances in exhibition by Millard West High School at 9:45. Awards for finals are at 10:15 PM. Drum majors and guard captains should report to the track for awards at 9:45 PM. A tentative outline of our finals schedule is below.

1 hour & 30 minutes prior to finals performance – In uniform with instruments & equipment
1 hour & 5 minutes prior to finals performance – Depart for warm up
1 hour prior to finals performance - Stretch/Warm up
30 minutes prior to finals performance – Front Ensemble/Props to gate
10 minutes prior to finals performance - Winds/Battery/Guard report to gate
Upon completion of finals performance, follow directors' instructions

What to bring

- Uniform: Remember all show uniform parts (hat, hat wrap, side cape, stirrups, gauntlets); **tall** black socks, shoes, etc. Also bring hair pins, hairspray, and etc to secure your hair under your hat.
- Meals: A light lunch or snacks and a meal at the competition will be provided by the Boosters. Students with food allergies or dietary restrictions should bring a sack lunch and plan accordingly. Bring cash for any additional food from concessions.
- Equipment: Be sure to have additional reeds, valve oil, etc.

Expectations

If we are not getting ready for a performance, performing, or packing up after our performance, everyone is expected to be watching other groups perform. When watching other groups perform, students are expected to sit as a band. All comments about other groups in public should remain positive. Students should show respect to other groups by following behavior norms during performances. Everyone is expected to have integrity when it comes to packing up uniforms and equipment. We should be determined to use the judges' feedback to improve the quality of our show. Finally, let's set the example of excellence by our behavior and performance.
